**Sending Messages** 

- It's best to write the message in a file on the computer first and transmit it to the packet BBS
- ALWAYS include your full return address in the message that you send

#### **Response to Ohad in Israel:**


#### Sending Messages - 2 Ways

- Upload to your local packet BBS
  - Upload the message your local Packet BBS system such as WO5H or N5AUX or WB5EKW in Abilene or W5SYT in Austin
  - Mesages will be routed by the particular BBS with their standard packeting routing (Note: PMS on TexNet does NOT forward messages)
- **Request the PACSAT gateway** 
  - Requires addressing format in PACSAT gateway information
  - Upload the message to your local Packet BBS systems

**Using Satellite Gateways - What Happens?** 


- Message is uploaded to local Packet BBS
- Message is forwarded to the satellite gateway station specified
- Message is formatted for a PACSAT and is uploaded to either UO-22, or KO23
- Message is downloaded by the gateway closest to the destination Packet BBS
- Message is reformatted for into regular packet format and passed via regular packet channels to the final destination Packet BBS

### **Using Satellite Gateways - How?**

- Prepare your message with internal addressing
- Select closest gateway site to your QTH
- Upload to your local Packet BBS system

- Be patient ... and keep trying. Not all messages or all CQ's will be answered






